The research methods and materials used in this study are as follows: James Lind's systematic literature review approach was used (Daroina et al. 2022). A systematic literature review aims to find, assess, and compare previous research findings with the current research.

The systematic review is to understand how the Grammarly app used by users and students can be appropriately understood to improve writing skills. The first step is to collect data from online search literature sources and visit 12 scientific journals discussing the Grammarly theme from various perspectives with various articles from 2020-2024. Then, the selected article data was presented in a table consisting of the author's name, year of publication, article title, and research results. Next, the researcher analyzes it by drawing conclusions that meet the principles of validity and reliability of the findings that have answered the questions. In this research design, the researcher chose an explorative qualitative descriptive method.

Perceptions of descriptive EFL students regarding Grammarly's efficacy as an automated writing evaluation (AWE). It was evident that the pupils thought utilizing the Grammarly app was fantastic.

Numerous benefits of Grammarly were listed, including the ability to detect mistakes in grammar, punctuation, spelling, and word choice in writing, the reduction of errors in written works, the enhancement of paraphrasing abilities, the ability to fix writing errors at any time and location, the enhancement of vocabulary in students, and the ease with which Grammarly can be used to find writing errors. Of course, Grammarly assists students with editing their work by identifying possible issues with grammar, spelling, punctuation, and vocabulary. Grammarly is a straightforward application that checks writing for spelling, grammar, and punctuation mistakes, helping students and academics with their writing. With a high degree of accuracy and review speed, Grammarly also offers thorough and beneficial feedback, including ideas and corrections to make writing more clear, precise, effective, legible, error-free, and impactful (Perdana, Manullang, and Masri, 2021).

(Maypida & Damanik, 2024) Explored the effectiveness of Grammarly as a support tool in improving English as a Foreign Language (EFL) writing skills, based on student perceptions showing that students generally had a positive perception of Grammarly and appreciated its ability to minimize grammatical errors, improve language style, and improve word choice and punctuation. However, some drawbacks were noted, such as the need for a stable internet connection and the limited functionality of the free version. (Wibawa & Nabhan, 2023) They explored students' perceptions of using Grammarly as an AI-powered writing assistant with a qualitative case study. Data was collected from college students using

Grammarly for their writing assignments through semi-structured interviews and document reviews in student writing portfolios. The results showed that students felt the benefits of this application, including improving their writing by helping them check sentence structure, providing suggested advanced vocabulary, an easy-to-use writing application, a freely accessible platform, and improving their writing skills.

(Armanda et al. 2022) They described the frequency of students using Grammarly to improve their writing skills. They used a descriptive qualitative method to explore students' perspectives on using Grammarly to check grammar when writing articles. Most EFL students had a favourable view of using Grammarly as an online grammar checker to help them write articles. As an English writing aid, evidence shows that Grammarly can check grammar and stylistic errors. This study has so far shed light on the good and bad aspects of using Grammarly among EFL students. In general, EFL students found Grammarly's ability to help write articles. (Fitria, 2021) Revealed an overview of 'Grammarly' as an AI-powered English Writing Assistant for EFL students in English Writing. Based on the results of her analysis, the use of Grammarly software showed a performance improvement. Before using Grammarly, students' test score performance was 34 out of 100. After using Grammarly, the students' text score performance was 77 out of 100. This score indicates that the quality of writing in this text has improved.

Grammarly has been widely recognized as an innovative and effective writing aid that offers various advantages in the context of English language education. First, Grammarly's ability to detect grammar and spelling errors greatly assists students in improving their writing in real-time. Second, Grammarly not only corrects errors but also provides suggestions for improvements in style and word choice, which can enrich students' vocabulary. Furthermore, the intuitive user interface and ease of access through various platforms make Grammarly an attractive option for students. This ease of use suggests that students feel more confident using this tool and are more motivated to write. With the combination of all these advantages, Grammarly is not just a tool but also a partner in students' academic journey, supporting them to become better and more confident writers.

The identify the shortcomings of Grammarly

Grammarly offers various advantages, some drawbacks need to be considered in the context of English language education. Firstly, reliance on this tool can reduce students' ability to learn independently. (Ahmad Rakan Arrona, et. al. 2024) in Astiti shows that students who rely too heavily on Grammarly tend to pay more attention to the basics of grammar and spelling, which can hinder the development of long-term writing skills. (Hutahaeen et al. 2023) Found weaknesses, such as Grammarly's inability to determine the author's tense in a certain amount of time. Simple past or straightforward present, for example. The use of Grammarly is also limited. If students want to use all the premium features of Grammarly, they must pay for it. The free version of Grammarly effectively detects minor errors such as comma errors and misuse of articles.

Meanwhile, the students used the accessible version of Grammarly in this study. As a result, the accessible version of Grammarly can only verify articles, spaces, and punctuation. It is possible that they were not satisfied with Grammarly's performance. In addition, customers must pay to access the premium version. Grammarly needs to improve in capturing the nuances of language and cultural context. According to (Pratama, 2020) The tool often needs help identifying more complex errors or interpretations requiring a deeper understanding of context. This can lead to students receiving inappropriate or irrelevant advice. (Malik, 2023) Excessive use of AI can also lead to dependence on technology and hinder the development of independent learning skills.

Expensive AI implementations can also create access gaps, and using AI involves collecting student data, which raises concerns about privacy and security. (Wardatin et al. 2022) Reports that technical difficulties sometimes ruin certain users' supposedly perfect Grammarly experience. These glitches highlight the need to assess the dependability and consistency of this tool, as users may have experienced issues that interfered with their writing productivity. (Tambunan, et al. 2022) Additionally, it emphasized Grammarly's deficiencies in content and structural analysis, highlighting the necessity for further guidance, particularly in educational contexts. This raises significant issues regarding the tool's efficacy in fostering a comprehensive comprehension of fundamental grammar and linguistic challenges.

Effective navigation of Grammarly's limitations necessitates teacher engagement and careful evaluation of its application.. (Astuti and Sumarni 2023) Their research emphasized the advantages and disadvantages of employing Grammarly to enhance students' autonomous learning, especially in writing proficiency, utilizing a qualitative literature analysis. Data was gathered from ten pertinent papers on Google Scholar. This paper examines the advantages and disadvantages of Grammarly from 2018 to 2023. The findings indicated that Grammarly can improve pupils' autonomous learning.

This is attributable to the benefits of Grammarly, which can assess accuracy, clarity, engagement, delivery, plagiarism, and convenience. Nonetheless, the drawbacks of Grammarly include the necessity for a reliable electrical supply and internet connection, high-speed internet access to utilize all functions, and limited services in the free edition, while the premium version incurs a fee. With these drawbacks in mind, users must realize that Grammarly should be used as a support tool rather than as a substitute for in-depth language learning.

CONCLUSION

From the literature review that has been conducted, it can be concluded that Grammarly as a writing tool has a very important role in supporting English learning, especially in improving writing skills. With its various advanced features, such as grammar checking, spelling, writing style, as well as improvement suggestions, Grammarly can help students correct technical errors in their writing efficiently and instantly. The use of this tool not only provides convenience in proofreading but also provides in-depth explanations that allow students to understand their mistakes, which ultimately supports independent learning in writing.

The various studies that have been discussed show that Grammarly can increase students' awareness of grammar and spelling errors and improve the overall quality of their writing. Some studies show that students who use Grammarly experience a significant improvement in their writing ability compared to those who do not use the tool. This proves that Grammarly can serve as a highly effective tool in supporting the learning process of English writing.

However, despite its many advantages, Grammarly also presents some challenges and limitations that need to be considered. One limitation is its inability to understand certain contexts or nuances in writing. This can result in suggestions that do not always match the writer's intent. In addition, over-reliance on Grammarly can reduce students' analytical and critical abilities in writing, which is a potential danger of reliance on this tool. Reliance on this tool can hinder the development of deeper writing skills, especially in terms of critical and creative thinking.

Furthermore, although Grammarly provides useful suggestions for technical improvements, it cannot fully replace the role of direct teaching in developing students' writing skills. Existing studies emphasize the importance of the teacher's role in assisting students in the learning process of writing, especially in the areas of idea development, analysis, and

creativity in their writing. Grammarly should be used as a supporting tool, not as a substitute for direct guidance and interaction with the teacher.

Overall, although Grammarly has many advantages in improving the quality of student writing, its use should be done wisely. The tool should be used as a companion in the writing learning process but should be different from the more in-depth aspects of teaching that require teacher involvement.

Based on the findings that have been discussed, some suggestions can be considered to maximize the benefits of using Grammarly in English language learning. To avoid over-dependence, Grammarly should be used as a tool that supports students' independent learning process. The use of this tool can help students correct errors instantly and provide useful feedback. However, students still need to be encouraged to develop their analytical and critical skills in writing. Students should be given the opportunity to reflect on their mistakes and understand the reasoning behind the suggestions given by Grammarly so that they can learn from each mistake found.

Grammarly is not supposed to substitute for direct teaching. Teaching that involves analyzing ideas, writing structures, and developing arguments remains very important in learning to write. Therefore, teachers need to combine Grammarly with teaching methods that emphasize critical and creative thinking skills and provide more in-depth guidance in aspects that technology cannot reach.

For students to make the most of Grammarly, they need to be trained on how to use the tool wisely. This training can include understanding the types of errors that Grammarly can detect and how to use the corrective suggestions provided to improve the quality of writing. Teachers also need to remind students not to rely entirely on this tool but to keep developing their writing skills as a whole.

In the context of online learning, where direct interaction with the instructor may be limited, Grammarly can act as a very useful tool to provide instant feedback and help students correct their mistakes without having to wait for a long time to get revisions from the instructor. However, online teaching involving technology should also be mindful of Grammarly's limitations in capturing the context or nuances of writing. Hence, students need to be taught to be more critical in assessing the advice given.

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
